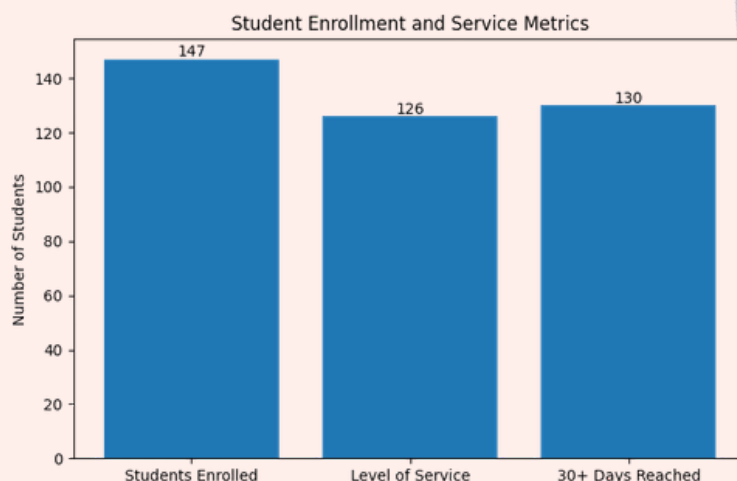


LEAP WITH THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS OF LOWER BERGEN COUNTY

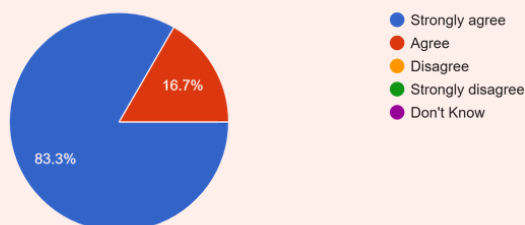

OF ATTENDEES WITH 30 DAYS OR MORE

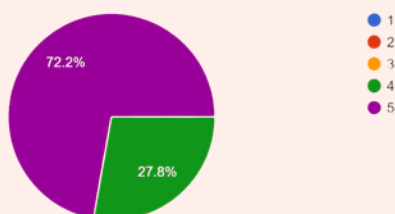


PARENT FEEDBACK

"Thank you, LEAP, for all your support and everything you do for my child."

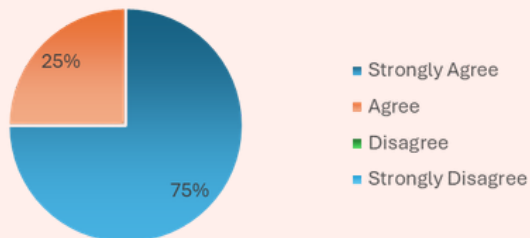
"My child enjoys going to leap, meeting new people and learning new skills."

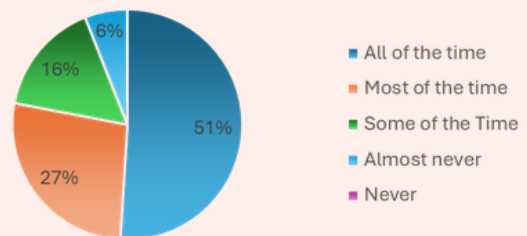

LEAP student comments

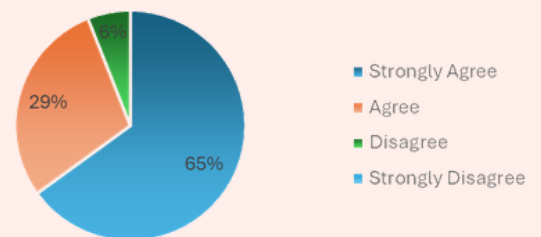
"I love cooking class, because I get to learn how to make things on my own and I get to be with my friends."
